

## **Another Day, Another Geyser: Main Street Floods During Rush Hour**

NORTHWOOD – Commuters on Main Street were met with an unexpected detour this morning as a geyser of water erupted from a failed water main near the corner of 4th Avenue. The break, which occurred around 7:30 a.m., flooded the intersection and forced the closure of two lanes for most of the day, causing significant traffic delays.

City crews were on the scene quickly, but this marks the third major water main failure in the last six months. 'It's getting ridiculous,' said local business owner Sarah Jenkins, whose coffee shop was left with low water pressure for hours. 'You start to wonder what you're paying taxes for.'

At a press conference, City Manager Maria Flores assured residents that public safety remains the city's top priority. 'Our crews are responding effectively to these unfortunate incidents,' Flores stated. 'We are also exploring more strategic, long-term solutions to ensure the reliability of our water system.'

For many residents, however, those solutions can't come soon enough.
